Many unified theories concentrate upon mathematical elegance. PTV instead concentrates upon physical mechanism. Its objective is not simply writing more compact equations but explaining why observed phenomena occur. That emphasis on causal mechanism gives the programme a distinctive character. An important strength of PTV compared with many alternative theories is that it remains experimentally vulnerable. It makes numerical predictions. It can therefore be wrong. This is a virtue rather than a weakness. Scientific theories should expose themselves to possible refutation. Accordingly I would regard it as one of the more scientifically developed realist alternatives presently available.

Many alternative theories remain at the conceptual stage for decades. PTV has already progressed through several increasingly quantitative applications. Although much work remains, it demonstrates characteristics associated with an active rather than static research programme.
